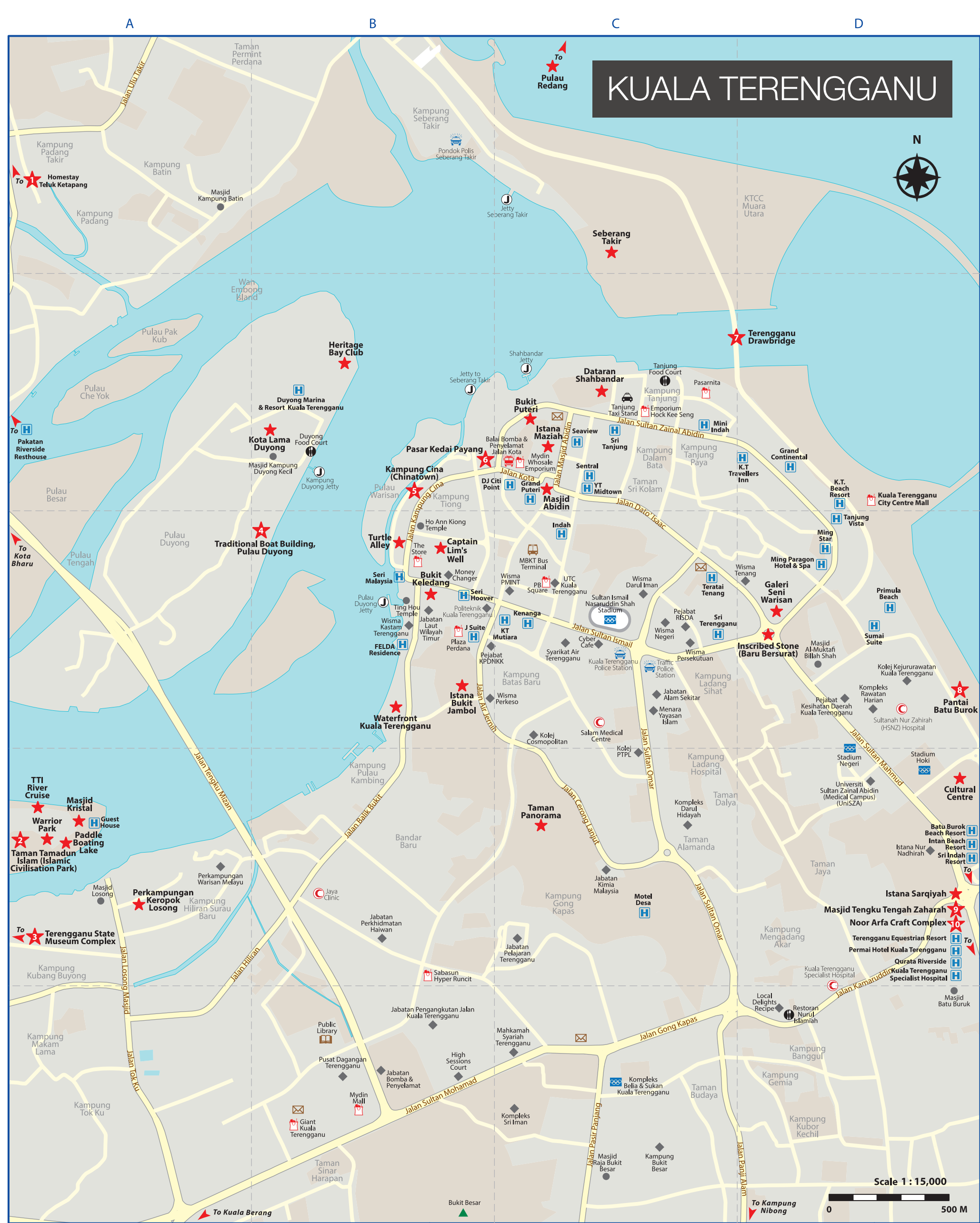

HOMESTAY TELUK KETAPANG

TAMAN TAMADUN ISLAM (ISLAMIC CIVILISATION PARK)

TERENGGANU STATE MUSEUM COMPLEX

Touted as the largest museum in Southeast Asia, the Terengganu State Museum Complex in Kampung Losong comprises a main museum, maritime museum, fisheries museum, traditional timber houses as well as botanic and herb gardens. Its vast collection of age-old artefacts, works of art and exhibits offers a glimpse into the state's rich heritage. The original Batu Bersurat is prominently displayed at the museum's main entrance.

TRADITIONAL BOAT BUILDING, PULAU DUUYONG

Pulau Duyong is a small island noted for its traditional boat building industry. The master craftsmen here are known to build boats and even yachts from memory and experience without the use of blueprints or nails. Visitors will have the opportunity to observe these skilled boat makers at work in numerous workshops around the island.

KAMPUNG CINA (CHINATOWN)

Established by the Chinese community in the late 19th century, Kampung Cina was once a major centre of commercial activity in its heyday. Today, its quaint streets are lined with souvenir shops, restaurants as well as a variety of other stores. It has been declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site under the World Monument Watch Programme to ensure the preservation of its pre-colonial heritage and buildings.

PASAR KEDA PAYANG

Kuala Terengganu's central market, Pasar Keda Payang, is a popular market frequented by both locals and visitors. Besides fresh local produce, the market offers a variety of traditional snacks, textiles, handicrafts, trinkets and more. The nearby Waterfront Heritage Bazaar is another must-visit for visitors to Terengganu as it boasts an interesting selection of shops selling all kinds of local handicrafts and delicacies.

TERENGGANU DRAWBRIDGE

A prestigious landmark in Terengganu, Terengganu Drawbridge is a grand structure spanning 638 metres, connecting the towns of Kuala Terengganu and Kuala Nerus. The bridge is a source of pride for the state as it has the distinction of being Southeast Asia's first tower drawbridge. Its 76-metre bascule is the longest ever to be built on a drawbridge. The walkways on the 15th floor give a chance for visitors to enjoy panoramic views of the South China Sea, Terengganu River and the sprawling city. More attractions include a gallery, an exciting semi glass-bottomed Sky Terrace and a restaurant.

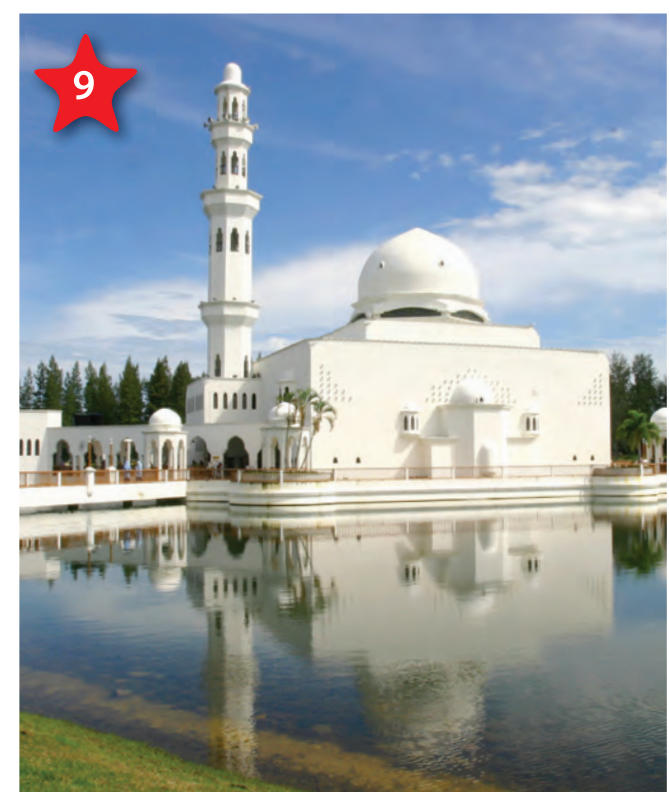


PANTAI BATU BUROK

Terengganu

A treasure trove of natural and cultural wonders, Terengganu is often fittingly referred to as the "Gem of the East Coast". Visitors will be captivated by its unspoiled landscape, dotted with quaint small towns, rustic coastal villages and verdant greenery. To sun and sea lovers, it is the gateway to some of Malaysia's most beautiful islands where diving and other leisure activities abound. Bordered by the South China Sea to the east, it boasts a 244km coastline, the longest in Peninsular Malaysia. Deeply rooted in traditional Malay culture, Terengganu showcases a variety of crafts, from boat building to batik printing.

GT GETTING THERE

Terengganu is accessible via an interconnected network of expressways and roads from all major towns and cities in Peninsular Malaysia. The state is also easily accessible by air with Malaysia Airlines, AirAsia and Firefly offering daily flights from Kuala Lumpur to the Sultan Mahmud Airport in Kuala Terengganu, just 14km from the city centre. Besides daily flights to Kuala Terengganu from Penang, Firefly also flies to Kerteh in Kemaman from Subang. SKS Airways operates daily direct flights from Kuala Lumpur to Redang Island.

GA GETTING AROUND

Getting around Kuala Terengganu is a breeze as Heritage City shuttle buses ply a fixed route past the city's top attractions. The starting point is at Taman Syahbandar, where visitors can choose from the two routes available. Taxis are also easily available in the city and major towns. Brightly-decorated trishaws are another attraction in Kuala Terengganu.



S SHOPPING

The best shopping experiences in Terengganu revolve around its cultural heritage and vibrant cottage industries. An endless array of shops selling all kinds of local products can be found at the Pasar Kedai Payang in Kuala Terengganu's city centre. Souvenir items include Terengganu handicrafts such as silversware, batik, songket, brassware as well as woven pandanus mats and baskets.

D DINING

Terengganu serves up a tempting variety of local delicacies which can be found almost everywhere in the state. Western cuisine is available at hotels while fast food outlets can be found in most major towns. Terengganu is well known for rice-based dishes such as *nasi dagang* with *gulai ikan tongkol* (spiced rice with spicy tuna curry), *nasi kunyit* (glutinous rice cooked in coconut milk and turmeric) and *nasi kerabu* (rice mixed with various herbs, spices and vegetables). Other must-try local delicacies here are the *keropok lekor* (crackers made from a mixture of fish and sago), *laksam* (flat rice noodles in a rich fish gravy) and *budu* (fermented anchovies).

KAMPUNG RAJA (WOODCARVING INDUSTRY)
Besut takes pride as the woodcarving capital of Terengganu. 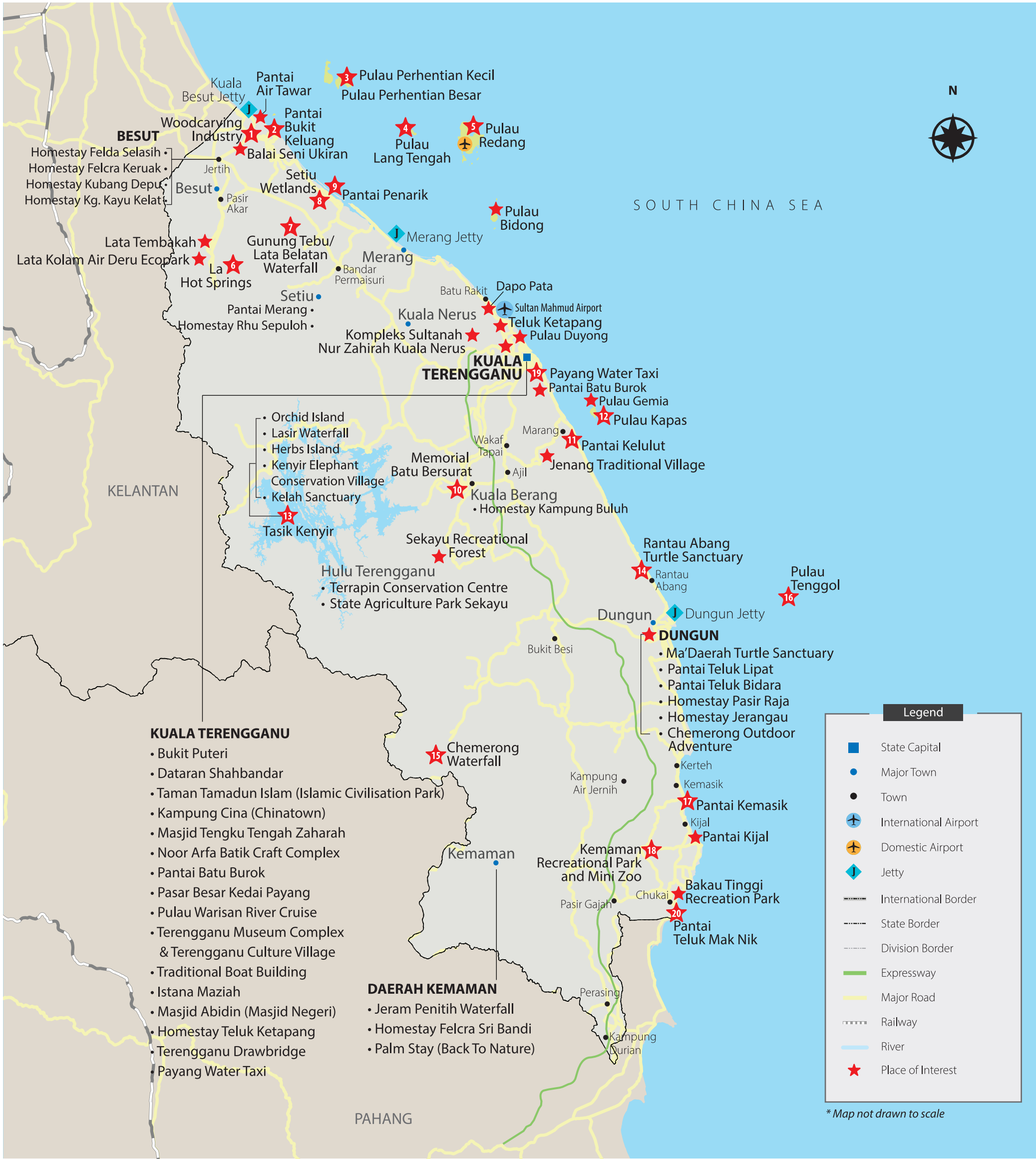

MEMORIAL BATU BERSURAT (MEMORIAL OF THE INSCRIBED STONE)

Dating back to the 4th century, the Batu Bersurat Terengganu is the earliest recorded evidence of the spread of Islam in the region. It is listed on the United Nations Memory of the World register, a UNESCO programme aimed at preserving the world's documentary heritage. A replica has been built as a memorial in Kampung Buluh, Kuala Berang, where it was first discovered in 1903.

TASIK KENYIR (LAKE KENYIR)

Malaysia's largest man-made lake sprawls over 38,000 hectares, dotted by 340 islands. Fringed by a pristine forest reserve, the lake and its hinterland are a paradise for nature activities such as jungle walks, fishing, kayaking, canoeing and birdwatching. Houseboats are a novel way to take in the sights. Major attractions are Lasir and Soak Waterfalls, Kenyir Elephant Conservation Village, Kelah Fish Sanctuary and caving at Gua Bewah.
